YEAR 4 YMCA CAMP - YARRAMUNDI Tuesday 25 September to Wednesday 26 September 2018

We are looking forward to attending YMCA Camp Yarramundi in a few weeks time. While we are at camp students will have the opportunity to take part in the following activities (weather permitting):

- 1. **Artificial Cave Maze** A teamwork and bonding activity. Students move through a series of obstacles in an artificial cave system.
- 2. **Giant Swing-** A 20 metre high harnessed swing. 'Challenge by choice' with the swinger in control of the release.
- 3. **Rock Climbing-** A 10 metre artificial wall with climbs to suit everyone.
- 4. **Archery-** The basic skills and techniques for shooting a bow and arrow on the range.

Please note that the students will not be participating in any swimming or water activities.

The camp checklist is listed below. Please ensure that all items are <u>clearly labelled with your</u> child's name.

Mobile phones, MP3 players, iPods, hand-held games etc are <u>not</u> to be brought to Yarramundi. The school will have mobile access to all staff members during the entire excursion if necessary.



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Tuesday 25th September

- Be at school by 8:45am to meet your teacher in the 3/4C classroom
- Wear comfortable casual clothes and closed-in shoes
- Don't forget your bags
- All medications are to be handed to your child's teacher prior to departure. Medications should be in plastic bags that are labelled with your child's name and dosage instructions. Please be aware teachers are unable to dispense non-prescribed medication without a letter from the doctor advising that your child requires the medication e.g. Analgesics, panadol and hay fever medication. This is a departmental requirement so if you think your child may need a non-prescribed medication, you should organise well in advance with the doctor for a letter. If your child suffers from chronic travel sickness, please make sure they take their medication prior to departure. We will endeavour to see that medication is taken at the appropriate times, with written parental instructions.
- Any souvenir orders, with the correct money, are to be in a sealed zip lock bag and handed to the class teacher.
