Infants and Primary Athletics Carnival 2022

Dear Parents/Caregivers

The details for the athletics carnival are as follows:

Students in Years 3-6, and those turning 8 in Year 2 this year, will compete in the primary carnival. Students in K, Year 1, and those turning 7 in Year 2 will participate in the infants' carnival. Both carnivals will be held on the same day. Year 2 students who are eligible for the 3-6 carnival may choose to participate in the K-2 carnival, but they need to choose one or the other. Please indicate this on the return slip.

Date: Wednesday 20 July 2022 (back up date Wednesday 27 July 2022)

Venue: Emu Plains Sporting Oval, Leonay

Uniform: Sports uniform with hat and sunscreen

Transport: All students are expected to come to school and walk with their teacher

to the oval.

Time: Students competing in the 1500m – Meet at the oval at 8:50am

(See Miss Mills prior to the carnival to enter your nomination)

Primary Students – Leave school approx. 9.10am for a 9.30am start.

Primary students will return to school by 3.00pm.

Infant Students - Arrive at oval at approx. 10.40am

Infant Students will leave the oval at approx. 1.30pm to return to school.

Bring: Recess, lunch and water for the day. Some snack items will be available to

preorder from the P and C. A note will follow.

Signing Out: Students may go home with their parents at the conclusion of the carnival

after they have reported to Miss Payne at the recorder's desk. If a child is to be taken by another parent or their grandparent, we require a note signed by the child's parent that indicates who will be signing their child out. This

is a requirement of the Department of Education.
