#### Classes 2022

Based on our current enrolment for 2021, our numbers indicate that 9 classes can be formed. If you are not returning in 2021, please complete the form at the end of the newsletter and return to the office immediately. Official enrolment numbers must be submitted to the Department of Education by Monday 14 February. Information regarding classes will be sent home at the beginning of 2022 when all children including Kindergarten are accounted for at school.

#### **2021 Presentation Assembly**

Due to current regulations in place regarding assemblies and presentations, our 2021 presentation assembly will be held via Zoom on Wednesday 8 December. We are still exploring the options.

As the school is currently operating in cohorts, we will need to hold three assemblies at different times.

Stage 2 - years 3 and 4 will commence at 9.30am

Early Stage 1 and Stage 1 - Kindergarten, years 1 and 2 will commence at 11am

Stage 3 - years 5 and 6 will commence at 12.30pm

All Leonay PS students receiving awards will receive a Zoom link for their designated time. The school will grant access to parents only for this assembly. All parents must be logged into the system by the designated start time. After this time no one will be admitted. This year each class teacher will give 6 awards in total.

#### Year 6 Farewell and Graduation

The guidelines for graduations and formals differ from assemblies and presentations. Based on the current guidelines, we will proceed as outlined below.

Year 6 Farewell will go ahead at Emu Plains Sports Club on Wednesday 1 December for year 6 students and limited staff members. There are several guidelines in place for this event that were emailed to Year 6 parents this week.

Year 6 Graduation will be on Thursday 16 December at 12 noon. At this stage, 1 fully vaccinated parent/carer per family wearing a mask, will be permitted to attend on school site. This will be confirmed prior to the day. The traditional arch at the end of that day will go ahead and end on the ballcourt. Parents will need to gather along the Buring Ave fence line to view this.

#### **Semester Two Student Reports**

These will be distributed on Wednesday 1 December. Information regarding Parent/Teacher Interviews for the following week starting Monday 6 December will be enclosed. We will use the same booking system from the beginning of the year for this event.

#### Last Day of 2021 and 2022 Commencement Dates

Thursday 16 December 2021 is the last day of school for students. Staff finish on Friday 17 December. In 2022, Year 1 to Year 6 return on Tuesday 1 February (there are two Staff Development days -28 and 31 January), whilst Kindergarten starts on Thursday 3 February.
