There are an increasing number of parents/caregivers who are sending homework and/or assignments through the school email account. As the school receives a large quantity of incoming emails, we cannot guarantee that these requests will be received by the teacher in the time you may expect. These should be sent in with your child and not through the email account. Digital homework/assignments can be put on an USB if required. This also helps your child to become more responsible for their own work and creates better learning habits. Thank you for your assistance in this matter.

Student Holidays

Any leave taken without the Principal's approval will be marked as not approved by the school and will be marked as unjustified. These forms must be completed prior and not retrospectively. This is a Departmental requirement. There are exceptions for funerals or bereavement where a student may have to travel during the school term.


Fairways Avenue: Designated Student drop off and pick up zone

Following a site visit from council's road safety officer Council's Signage Crew have been asked to install 3 x yellow student drop/pick up signs above the existing 'No Parking' signs that front Leonay Public School - Fairways Ave, Leonay to assist motorists to clearly identify the student drop off and pick up zone.

As part of our road safety messages to families that utilize this zone, the key message for motorists include:

- If you use the 'No Parking' designated student drop off and pick up zone: the driver has 2 minutes to set down or pick up passengers the driver must remain within the vehicle or only get out to help with children's bags and seatbelts if the zone is full, you are required to drive on and find alternate safe and legal on street parking (park and walk) or drive back to check if there is space for your vehicle within the zone.
- Do not stop or park your vehicle within the 'No Stopping' zones associated with the pedestrian crossing. Your vehicle may block sightlines for child pedestrians and motorists increasing the risk of a crash.
- If driving, 'park and walk' is a great option. By parking in nearby streets and walking you allow time to walk and talk with your children, increase your fitness and avoid the stress of traffic queuing.
