Entry to Opportunity Class for Year 5 in 2023

Opportunity classes cater for highly achieving academically gifted students. These classes help gifted and talented students to learn by grouping them with other gifted and talented students, teaching them in specialised ways and providing educational materials at the appropriate level. Applications for opportunity class placement are considered mainly on the combined results of the Opportunity Class Placement Test and school assessments. The Opportunity Class Placement Test will be held on **Thursday 28 July 2022**.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 5 opportunity class entry in 2023, you need to apply soon. You will need to apply on the internet using a valid email address (not the student's email address).
