NAPLAN 2022 results are fabulous!!!



I am very pleased to report that our 2022 NAPLAN results for years 3 and 5 are exceptional. Congratulations to the year 3 and 5 students, the hardworking staff and supportive community on these outstanding achievements.

The graph below highlights the number of students who achieved in the top two bands for Reading and Numeracy. Our growth over the past years has been as a result of some really intensive programs that have been implemented into classrooms at Leonay PS. I thank all the staff who have been an integral part of this ongoing development.



School Targets

Our Strategic Improvement Plan for Leonay PS contains targets in reading and numeracy to be met in 2022. Based on previous achievements, each school has a lower and upper bound range.

I am delighted to say that in both Reading and Numeracy, we not only met our targets but actually exceeded the upper bound point. This is a fantastic achievement, and I am proud of all the work we have done to achieve this.

Year 3 Writing

Students in year 3 usually fall within band 1 to 6 in NAPLAN, with the norm being bands 3 and 4. Our current cohort of year 3 students all scored band 4 or higher in Writing in 2022. An outstanding achievement for our students. They have worked hard in K-2 and this year on our targeted Read to Write program and the evidence is certainly in the results.

Staffing changes 2022

Ms Rothwell - I have received notification that Ms Rothwell will continue in the position at Kurrajong East PS until the end of the term. Mrs Devine and Mrs Foskett will continue to cover Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. *Mrs Devine* - This is to inform you that Friday 16 September will be Mrs Devine's final day at Leonay PS for 2022. Mrs Devine is taking leave for the remainder of the year. Mrs Demuth has happily agreed to work on Thursday and Friday until the end of the year. This will start in week 10, Thursday 22 September and continue until the end of Term 4.

NSW Department of Education Staffing Changes-2023

For 2023 all schools have been allocated a new position - Assistant Principal Curriculum and Support. This position will oversee literacy and numeracy within the school through mentoring teachers and monitoring data and student achievements. Leonay PS received a 4-day a week position. It is a permanent position that has been filled through the Merit Selection process.

I would like to congratulate Mrs Garbutt-Young who was successful in gaining this position at Leonay PS. She will maintain one library day as well.

I would also like to congratulate Mrs Peen who was successful in gaining this position at Jamisontown PS, 5 days a week, starting 2023.

Maths Enrichment Project with Nepean CAPA HS

17 students from Leonay PS have attended two Maths Enrichment sessions at Nepean Creative and Performing Arts HS this term. The aim of these sessions is to provide extension opportunities in problem solving and engage in a range of mathematical challenges. Our students are working with a select group of Year 8 students, including some past Leonay students. This initiative has allowed for a greater connection to be formed between the two schools. I look forward to many more collaborations with our local high school.

Penrith/Blue Mountains Dance Festival

Congratulations to our Junior and Senior dance groups who performed at the Joan Sutherland Performing Arts Centre on Wednesday at matinee and twilight sessions. All Leonay students performed beautifully at both sessions. Thank you to Mrs Peen and Mrs Longhurst for all their time and efforts at school leading up to the performances and during this week. I thoroughly enjoyed watching the twilight performance.

Kindergarten Enrolments

Kindergarten Enrolments for 2023 are now open. Enrolments can be completed through the Leonay PS website. Children may be enrolled in Kindergarten at the beginning of the school year if they turn five years of age by 31 July of that year. Applications to enrol for students in the Leonay area can be made online through the school's website by clicking on the enrolments tab. Out of area applications can now also be made online from the website and include additional documentation as part of the process. Once received the office will email you with further instructions. Voluntary School Contributions

Each year public primary and secondary schools across NSW request financial contributions from their community to enhance the school's educational programs. This request occurs because there are no actual fees to attend public schools. These voluntary contributions help provide additional educational resources for the benefit of our students. Our voluntary contribution for this year is \$50 per child. Payments can be made at any stage online through the website or at our front office.

Permission and Payment Due Dates

There has been a significant number of permission/payments not being received by the due date for a variety of school activities. The school will send a reminder via Compass as a courtesy but this is not a guarantee. The dates for events are on the calendar on the front of the newsletter and students are reminded regularly by teachers.

The school asks that if you are not able to send in the permission and/or payment on the due date that you contact the office and advise as a courtesy. That way we can manage the organisation of events as we then have a clearer picture of who will be attending and those not attending. We will accommodate any request for an extension.

If you do not contact the school to request a late payment/permission it will be assumed that your child is not attending and will not be accounted for. There will be a strict rule applied to those who do not contact the school prior to the due date. In those instances, the student will not be able to attend unless there are extenuating circumstances. We also ask that you sign one note per child and do not put multiple children on one note.

Road Safety Around the School

We have received various reports from parents about students who are running out of school gates in the afternoon and very often running across the road from behind parked cars. In particular, students not using the crossing on Fairways Ave correctly. Staff have spoken to the students in regard to road safety but I ask that you have the same conversation with your children to reinforce the point. If your child rides their bike to and from school, please remind them that they should walk their bike across the pedestrian crossing and on school grounds. Some parents are also pulling up on the No Stopping sign on Buring Avenue before the school gates. This is very dangerous. Parents should park in legal stopping zones or use the Kiss N Ride on Fairways Avenue. It is everyone's responsibility to look after each other by being respectful of road rules.
