2026 Kindergarten Enrolments - OPEN

Applications are now open for children eligible to start Kindergarten in 2026. Children may be enrolled in Kindergarten at the beginning of the school year if they turn five years of age by 31 July of that year. Applications to enrol for students in the Leonay area can be made online through the school's website by clicking on the enrolments tab. Out of area applications can now also be made online from the website and include additional documentation as part of the process. Once received the office will email you with further instructions. If you know of anyone in the Leonay area who is considering enrolling, encourage them to do so now. Please ring the office if you have any questions.

School Uniform

Our uniform is an important part of the school's identity, as well allowing students to learn and play in comfort and safety. Unfortunately, many students have been wearing a variety of colours and styles of clothes, jackets and shoes that are not part of our school's uniform. We appreciate that children grow quickly, are quite tough on their school clothing and shoes and that new uniform can be quite expensive. So, if your child needs some new uniform items, please contact the P and C Facebook site or the school office with your request. Students are expected to wear black shoes every day, except Friday for years 3-6 and Tuesday for years K-2, when sports shoes are permitted. There are lots of jumpers sitting on the lost property hooks near the canteen at the moment. Send your child to look or parents are welcome to pop in before or after school to have a look. We try to return any with names on them to the students as soon as possible.

Semester One Student Progress Reports

These reports will be distributed to families on Monday 30 June. They will be available as a PDF through our Compass system. You can also access by logging into to your child's portal. Please note reports stay active for families in the student's portal while you are a member of Leonay PS. If you leave the school or when your child goes to high school, you will no longer have access to this information. I highly recommend you download and save all reports.

Raising Concerns

From time-to-time parents and carers may need to raise a concern about the academic progress or welfare of their child or to follow up from an incident involving their child in the playground. Please do not approach any other students involved. The first person you should contact is your child's teacher to arrange a time to discuss the concern. You can do this by emailing or phoning the office. Please do not interrupt teachers during their teaching time to make these arrangements. The Assistant Principal supervising each stage, K-2 Ms Finlayson and 3-6 Mrs Longhurst may be of assistance especially if it is a playground concern. We thank you in anticipation of your support.

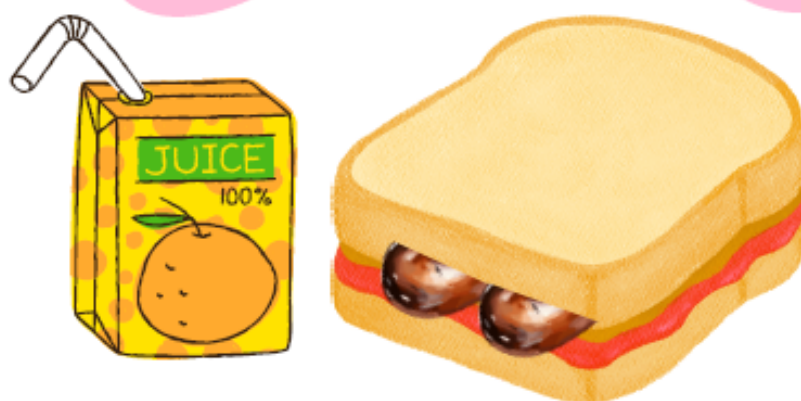
Colour Run - Thursday 12 June 2pm
